

April 8 Solar Eclipse Preparations

The exercise on February 7 be a workshop/table top exercise to identify and discuss the potential consequences of that kind of convergence, determine roles and responsibilities, and work through a table top scenario to further understand our capabilities and develop a plan to mitigate and respond to the event.
